The marriage of the Prince of Wales (the Prince Regent, later King George IV) to Caroline of Brunswick was a well-publicised disaster, but hopes for the future of the monarchy rested with their daughter, Charlotte. After a turbulent adolescence she married the man of her choice, but the couple's happiness was cruelly cut short by her death in childbirth. A shocked nation was plunged into grief for its people's princess, the queen who never was.
