

Roman Britain



Camulodunum (Colchester)

This session will begin in 55 BCE with the first of Caesar's two invasions of Britannia and then progress to look at the invasion and colonisation almost 100 years later under Emperor Claudius. It will follow the initially quick process of settlement that led to the triumphant procession of Claudius, astride an elephant, into the new capital city of Camulodunum (Colchester). We will then look at the challenge to settlement caused by both Boudicca and the Druids of Mona (Anglesey). We will then jump ahead to the building of Hadrian's Wall alongside a discussion of the Romanisation of Britannia.
